Herman F. Welch (1920-2013)

Long – time member Herman F. Welch, age 93, passed away on December 18, 2013. Herman survived his wife Lorraine.

Born in Roodhouse, Illinois, he was a former resident of Cicero, Downers Grove, Chicago, and Morris. Herman and Lorraine moved to Morris in 1995. A World War II

Naval Veteran, Herman retired from G.M. Electromotive Div. in 1974 as a supervisor.

An avid trapshooter, Herman won the **Grand American Handicap of 1967.**

Prior to his passing, Herman was the oldest surviving Grand American Champion. An inductee in the Illinois Trapshooting Hall of Fame, he will be missed by the entire trapshooting community.

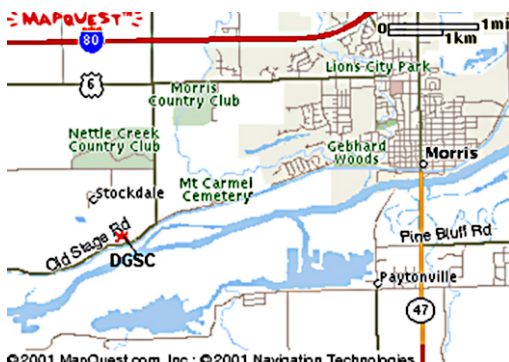

Please be prompt. Late shooters will shoot make up targets. All Shooters please check your receipt for correct classes & special categories.

We cannot make changes after you shoot!

- \$3.00 ATA Daily Fee added to 1st event per day.
- Shooters declaring a "Special Category" must take that trophy over their yardage group if their score qualifies for both.
- All Shoot Offs will be at the conclusion of the last Event of each day
 - All Ties for Champion and 1st Place with be Shot Off (Handicap Event - 25 Targets)
 - All others will be decided by reverse score
- Jr. & Sub-Jr. Shooters: \$20.00 per 100 targets plus ATA/ISTA fees if NO OPTIONS are played.
- Per new ATA rules, no more than 1 yard difference between posts & 2 yards total for 18, 19 & 20 yard shooters.
- Shoot Management reserve the right to refuse any entry

without explanation or refund the entry of anyone interfering with the harmony of the shoot.

- Shoot Management reserve the right to change, postpone or cancel any portion of the program in the event of conditions beyond our control.
