Did You Know- After the senseless tragedy at the Parkland Florida school, anti gun special interest groups are using social media to put pressure on NRA partner businesses to drop their affiliations? Some of these businesses have already bowed to the pressure and severed ties with the NRA.

One of the first to turn tail and run was First National Bank of Omaha, who offers the NRA co-branded credit card promoted as the "official credit card of the NRA."

They said they would not renew their contract with the NRA.

In the spirit of cooperation I have cut up my NRA credit card from them, and will mail it in with a copy of this newsletter. I urge my fellow 500+ members to do the same, and spread the word.
